Where Are We Going?

This seven day Korea tour will focus on six main parks and some smaller parks along the way. Lotte World (Aqua Trax and more!), Tongdo Fantasia (The only Arrow Triple Corkscrew!), Gyeongju World (New B&M Invert), Woobang Towerland (Four Credits), Kumdoriland (Crazy Vekoma Looper), Everland (Arrow Suspended), and more!

When Are We Going?

You should plan to arrive at ICN Seoul Airport on Monday, September 17, by 9pm. You will be met by the group and will start the tour. The tour will end back at ICN Seoul Airport on Sunday, September 23 at 7am. Feel free to add on days to your trip either before or after! We can help you with other add on options (Like Japan!)

How Much Will This Cost?

Because of changing exchange rates we cannot give an exact price at this time. We can give a range of \$1500 - \$1600 per person based on double occupancy. (£800 –

£875 or €1250 – €1325) Final price will be announced closer to the trip.

What Does That Price Get Me?

- All Ground Transportation starting at ICN Airport on 9/17/07 and ending at ICN Airport on 9/23/07.
- All Lodging from Monday Night 9/17/07 to Saturday Night 9/22/07.
- **Three Meals a Day**
- All Park Admissions (and there will be at least eight Different Parks!)
- TPR Exclusive Luggage tags
- Photo CD of the Trip
- Park Perks *Perks are still pending and will be announced closer to the trip. Do not expect much if any ERT as it is not a common practice in Asia *
- Access to Exclusive Messageboard on TPR to discuss trip specifics and questions that may arise.

Your trip fee covers the cost of the following: all transportation detailed in the trip flyer, overnight accommodations, park entrances, all relevant taxes, road tolls, gas, parking, drivers, etc. Theme Park Review will do its best to arrange park perks, but they cannot be guaranteed.

Participants aged 17 and under as of September 17, 2007 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Note that the pace of the trip will be fairly rigorous, mornings as early as 5am, nights as late as midnight. This will NOT be the case EVERY day, but do be prepared. All transportation will be by private coach.

Theme Park Review cannot be held responsible for anyone that misses the start of the trip due to flight delays or any other travel issues. Everyone should plan to arrive in ample time for the start of the tour. Trip participants are also responsible for arriving on time to all scheduled departures. The group WILL depart on time and will not wait for latecomers. If you are late for any meeting, you will be responsible to meet up with the tour at your cost/trouble. Ask anyone from the UK Trip, if you are 1 minute late WE WILL LEAVE! This is how we can make every attempt to stay on schedule for this crazy trip!

We strongly recommend that you take out your own insurance policy to cover health, third party liability and trip cancellation costs.

The payment of registration fees by, for, or on behalf of participants releases and holds harmless Theme Park Review and its representatives from any and all liabilities related to those activities.

We reserve the right to alter the itinerary for reasons such as operational problems, acts of war, etc. We will try to notify you prior to departure where possible or by announcements during the trip. We will try to offer suitable alternatives where possible. Keep in mind it rains A LOT in Korea. Expect at least one day to be a complete rainout, and rain about one third of the time. In the event of a park rainout, we will make every effort to rearrange itineraries and go back to places we missed, etc. but DO expect to miss a few credits due to weather and/or operations.

If you wish to cancel your place on the trip, then we must receive notice at least 4 weeks prior to departure. Any trip costs incurred on your behalf will be retained up to the value of the money paid so far. If cancellation notification is received less than 4 weeks prior to departure, any trip costs incurred on your behalf may be retained from your trip payment, and you may be asked to reimburse us if costs incurred exceed what you have paid. Theme Park Review reserves the right to cancel the trip for any reason. In the event of a cancellation any monies paid to Theme Park Review will be refunded.
