Where Are We Going?

This 17 Day Japan Tour will focus more on the less visited southern parks, not as many of the Tokyo area ones. We will be visiting: Space World, Mitsui Greenland, Kijima, Central Park, Universal Osaka, Expoland, Tivoli Park, Parque Espana, Nagashima Spaland, Hamanako Pal Pal, Lagunasia, Fuji-Q, Tokyo Disney & MORE!

When Are We Going?

You should plan to arrive at either Narita or Haneda Tokyo Airport on Saturday, September 1, 2007. You will have a rail pass and detailed instructions on how to get to the first Tokyo hotel on your own. The tour will end back in Tokyo on Sunday, September 16. Feel free to add on days to your trip either before or after! We can help you with other add on options!

How Much Will This Cost?

Because of a changing itinerary and exchange rates we cannot give an exact price at this time. We can give a range of \$3800 - \$4000 per person based on double occupancy. (£2100 - £2200 or €3000 - €3150) Final price will be announced closer to the trip.

What Does That Price Get Me?

- All Ground Transportation (including Bullet Trains, Monorails, Taxis, Buses, and more!) starting at a Tokyo Airport on 9/1/07 and ending at a Tokyo Airport on 9/16/07.
- All Lodging from Saturday Night 9/1/07 to Saturday Night 9/15/07.
- At least one meal per day
- All Park Admissions (and there will be at least 20 Different Parks!)
- TPR Exclusive Tour Shirt/Luggage tags
- DVD of Photos & Video of the Trip
- Group Photo
- Park Perks *Perks are still pending and will be announced closer to the trip. Do not expect much ERT as it is not a common practice in Japan *
- Access to Exclusive Messageboard on TPR to discuss trip specifics and questions that may arise.

Space is **extremely limited. A \$250 deposit reserves your spot and is fully refundable until March 1st, 2007 should you not be able to attend. Deposits **must** be postmarked by October 12th. If we have more deposits than spots available there will be a lottery in late October.

On March 1st another deposit of \$2000 is required and both deposits are no longer refundable. Final payment of the remaining balance will be due by May 30th. Please make checks payable to Theme Park Review.

While this will be the most comprehensive trip TPR has ever done and you are sure to have a GREAT time, please be aware that this trip is more for the "seasoned traveler" as you'll need to pay attention to instructions given about trains, taxis, meeting locations, etc. Think "TPR meets

Your trip fee covers the cost of the following: all transportation detailed in the trip flyer, overnight accommodations, park entrances, all relevant taxes, road tolls, gas, parking, drivers, etc. It does not include any meals apart from those advertised in the itinerary. Theme Park Review will do its best to arrange park perks, but they cannot be guaranteed.

Participants aged 17 and under as of September 1, 2007 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Note that the pace of the trip will be rigorous, mornings as early as 5am, nights as late as midnight. This will NOT be the case EVERY day, but do be prepared. Most hotels will have full service restaurants, but may not be an amenity at all hotels. All Transportation will be by public means; this means a lot of walking, stairs, train stations, and very little English. You will be responsible for staying close to your group leader and not getting lost or separated. Details regarding food, language, and the culture of Japan will be addressed on the forum and over emails with trip participants.

Theme Park Review cannot be held responsible for anyone that misses the start of the trip due to flight delays or any other travel issues. Everyone should plan to arrive in ample time for the start of the tour. Trip participants are also responsible for arriving on time to all scheduled departures. The group WILL depart on time and will not wait for latecomers. If you are late for any meeting, you will be responsible to meet up with the tour at your cost/trouble. Ask anyone from the UK Trip, if you are 1 minute late WE WILL LEAVE! This is how we can make every attempt to stay on schedule for this crazy trip!

We strongly recommend that you take out your own insurance policy to cover health, third party liability and trip cancellation costs.

The payment of registration fees by, for, or on behalf of participants releases and holds harmless Theme Park Review and its representatives from any and all liabilities related to those activities.

We reserve the right to alter the itinerary for reasons such as operational problems, acts of war, etc. We will try to notify you prior to departure where possible or by announcements during the trip. We will try to offer suitable alternatives where possible. Keep in mind it rains A LOT in Japan. Expect at least one day to be a complete rainout, and rain about one third of the time. In the event of a park rainout, we will make every effort to rearrange itineraries and go back to places we missed, etc. but DO expect to miss a few credits due to weather and/or operations. Japan parks are open year round with weird schedules, so major rides sometimes take two or three tries to get! This is very common throughout Japan.

If you wish to cancel your place on the trip, then we must receive notice at least 4 weeks prior to departure. Any trip costs incurred on your behalf will be retained up to the value of the deposit. If cancellation notification is received less than 4 weeks prior to departure, any trip costs incurred on your behalf may be retained from your trip payment, and you may be asked to reimburse us if costs incurred exceed what you have paid. Theme Park Review reserves the right to cancel the trip for any reason. In the event of a cancellation any monies paid to Theme Park Review will be refunded.
