- **CHECK-IN** You're welcome to enjoy the park on Friday & Saturday. To pick up your park admission tickets and credentials, please park in the Soak City lot and enter through the Soak City / Resort entrance gate. Registration is open from 9:00AM – 6:00PM on Friday, July 18 only!
- **CREDENTIALS** You'll receive your laminate ID at check-in. You'll need it for access to all activities. Tuck it down your shirt or secure it in a cargo pocket when you ride – we didn't print extras!
- **EQUIPMENT** Nobody wants to carry their gear onto Millennium Force when they ride. Or at Pagoda when they shop. So, you can move your gear in beginning at 9:00PM. Please come to the Soak City/Resort Gate for your campsite assignment. You'll be doing the moving, by the way.
- **TENTS** You'll need a tent if you're camping. We know you may want to just snooze in a sleeping bag, but we're afraid you'll roll down the midway if you're on an incline. Tents must be secured to the ground by stakes (in the grass) or by weight (if on the concrete).
- **RE-ENTRY** Once the evening activities begin, we will secure the perimeter like a battlefield. But don't battle. It's for your safety. So once you're in, you're in.
- **POWER** Unless your power charger plugs into the dirt or uses the night sky to keep a charge, you won't find outlets. Please plan accordingly!
- **SAFETY** Look! That "safety" word again! It's our first priority at the park. So leaving the designated camping area, roaming the midways in search of an elephant ear, climbing on rides or trying to sneak in a weight-guessing game for free are not good ideas.
- **FIRES** Safety first, kids. No campfires permitted. And if you need to smoke a cig, please do so in the designated smoking area near the Frontiertown Train Station.
- **PERSONAL STUFF** It's probably best to leave the Rolex, diamond necklaces and other bling at home.
- **WEATHER** We'll let you know if things get ugly. Follow @TonyClarkCP on Twitter for updates.
- **OUTHOUSE** The Skyhawk and Comfort Station restrooms are your go-to places.
- **BASE CAMP ALPHA** The Frontiertown Family Care Center is Camp 'Rou Headquarters. This is also First Aid. And where you'll go if you have questions.
- **BEHAVE** Be respectful of those around you (don't bring the boombox). Quiet hours are 2AM – 6:30AM.
- **SHOWERS** Hose yourself down inside our fancy showers, located in the Gemini parking lot just outside the Soak City gate. The water will be on from 6AM – 11AM.
- **CLEANUP** Wake-up call on July 19 is 6:30AM. Don't say we didn't warn you! Please begin packing up at this time, especially if you want to take advantage of the activities from 7AM – 9AM. We'll need you to be clear of Frontiertown by 8:30AM. Oh, and please clean up any debris you may have left behind. A clean park is a happy park!

Flashlights • Folding camping chairs • Bedding • Medication
Tents (no larger than 10' x 10') • Child care products
