Check-in:

- Check-in for the event will be **8:00AM – 9:00AM** in front of the park main entrance.
- Tickets not claimed during the allotted check-in times will be left at the “will call” booth for pick up.

SLEEPY HOLLOW MOUNTAIN - New for 2010 – Log Ride
